Dear Parents and Carers,

As we head into the autumn term, we want to make sure all our pupils stay healthy and happy throughout the flu season. One of the best ways to protect your child - and the wider school community - is by getting the annual flu vaccine.

### Who is the flu vaccine for?

All primary school children in England are eligible for the **free flu vaccine**. It is offered every year to help protect children and those around them from the flu.

### How is it given?

For most children, the vaccine is given as a **nasal spray** - quick, painless, and needle-free!

### ? Why is it important?

- Helps protect your child from flu
- Reduces time off school
- Protects more vulnerable family and community members
- Helps ease pressure on the NHS

### When will this happen?

The NHS flu vaccination team will be visiting Bridge Hall Primary School on 24th September 2025 :
