

# Attendance Matters at Bridge Hall Primary School



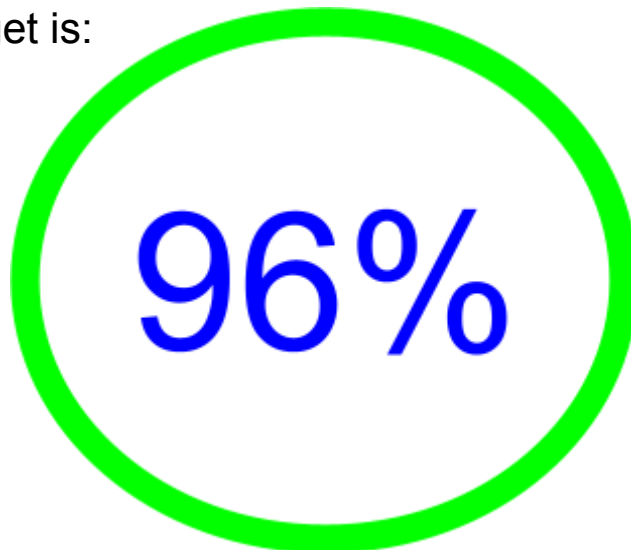
Regular attendance is vital for your child's academic success, confidence, and friendships. Aiming for 100% attendance helps children build essential life habits, while missing school disrupts learning.

In September, we will be looking closely at your child's attendance and we will take action if this drops below 96%.

Attendance includes punctuality. Your child should be at school before 8.55am when the register is taken. Arriving late disrupts the start of their day, meaning they will miss vital learning in Maths and English. If your child is too ill, and really can't attend school, please report this to school as soon as possible. Even if one child is poorly, it is vitally important that siblings still come to school on time.

Miss Howarth works closely with our Educational Welfare Officer to identify families who are persistently absent or late to school and offer support to improve each child's percentage attendance.
